Job Description: Full and Part Time Educators/Trainers

Full and Part Time Positions focus on teaching youth, K-12, lessons and lesson series on alcohol, tobacco, other drugs; conflict resolution and mediation; and prevention skills such as anger management, self-esteem, decision-making, friendship, and peer pressure. Candidates will also present prevention programs to faculty and parent groups.

Full Time Hours: 9:00 to 5:00 pm, Monday through Friday, year round with vacation, sick time, paid holidays and medical benefits.

Part Time Hours: 20-32 hours per week, 4-6 hours daily during normal school hours for the regular academic year, September through May.

Responsibilities Include:

- Learning about alcohol, tobacco, other drugs, violence, addiction and the prevention/treatment field.
- Teaching drug-specific and prevention lessons and lesson series to children in classrooms, K-12 and small group settings.
- Researching and implementing new lessons/presentations.
- Assisting with faculty and parent workshops.
- Working cooperatively and with accountability in a team setting.

- Experience teaching or training youth.
- Have a track record that demonstrates a strong work ethic.
- Have strong public relations and leadership skills.
- Be able to take initiative and work independently.
