Missouri educators, all school staff, students, and parents deserve to know if their school has an increased risk of exposure to COVID-19. Transparency and preparedness can help reduce the risk. MNEA has no way of independently verifying each instance but has no reason not to trust these reports. To be safe, check with your school for individual verification if your work or learning environment may be impacted.
