	 The essay MUST be written/typed on a separate sheet of paper and taped to the back of the poster. Poster and essay MUST reference the theme and Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Use pencils, crayons, paints, markers or color pencils for posters. A completed entry form must be taped to each poster. Posters should be on 11" x 17" white paper. Poster lamination is optional. COLLAGES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. ESSAYS WITHOUT POSTERS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. POSTERS WITHOUT ESSAYS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
