

# Karlovetz-Favero Scholarship Application

Martha Karlovetz, past President of MNEA and MNEA-Retired, has been an Association Activist at the local, state, and national levels since MNEA was established in 1973. Her daughter, Linda Favero, was a building rep and a MNEA-RA delegate. Her seven-year career as an elementary teacher was cut short due to a brain tumor. Linda's courage and positive attitude during her struggle served as an inspiration to students, parents, and colleagues. She inspired one second grader to write a poem, "The Classroom is Bare . . . the Teacher's not There!" This became the inspiration and the title of a book Martha wrote in honor of her daughter but also to clearly illustrate the difference that teachers make in the classroom.

**Eligibility:** Applicant must be an **NEA Aspiring Educators member currently enrolled in a Missouri teacher education program and pursuing a career in teaching.** Funds are to be used for undergraduate work in the fall semester.
