2022 Educators Rising Missouri VIRTUAL Competition Requirements Outline

Detailed competition information, requirements and scoring guides can be accessed on the national Educators Rising website, at https://www.educatorsrising.org, under Student Resources. Students may enter up to two events. If a student is a presenter for a chapter competition, that counts as an event entry. All students entering a Missouri competition must pay 2021-2022 national dues of **\$10 by Tuesday, Feb. 1, 2022.**

Each chapter is limited to 2 varsity and 2 JV entries in each individual competition, and one entry in each chapter competition. Eight competitions are open to middle school students, up to 2 entries per chapter in each. **Each chapter with students who compete needs to recruit a judge/timekeeper.** Judges must be able to access materials from the internet before the event and join an online judges training.

All students competing must also register to attend the conference by Tuesday, Jan. 25, 2022 at <u>www.mnea.org/edrising</u>. Conference registration fee is \$15. All students competing must also complete online entry form by midnight, Jan. 25, link coming by Jan. 5. All documents to be submitted in advance must be emailed to <u>Laurie.Bernskoetter@mnea.org</u> by Feb. 3. Links to required videos and recorded presentations are due Feb. 22. All files should be labeled with the following format: LastName.FirstInitial.competition.material.2022. Example: Jarrett.A.ExplAdmin.Interview.2022.

Entrants grant Missouri National Education Association, the state coordinator of Educators Rising Missouri, the right to post photos of students for promotional purposes on websites, social media, and printed materials. Entrants may not make any requests about their competition time. Competitions will be March 8 between 9 a.m. and 9 p.m. and March 9 from 9 to noon.
