

2023 Missouri Competition Requirements Outline



Detailed competition information, requirements and scoring guides can be accessed on the national Educators Rising website, at www.educatorsrising.org, under Student Resources. Students may enter up to two events at state-level, but only one event at national-level. If a student is a presenter for a chapter competition, that counts as an event entry. All students entering a Missouri competition must pay the 2022-2023 \$10 national dues **by Jan. 31, 2023**, through Educators Rising at www.educatorsrising.org.

Each chapter is limited to (2) varsity and (2) Junior Varsity entries in each competition. Eight competitions are open to middle school students (grades 7-8), up to (2) entries per chapter in each. If two or more students present together and they are in different grade ranges, they compete at the older level. **Each chapter with students who compete needs to recruit a judge/timekeeper.** Judges must be able to access materials from the Internet before the event and join an online judges training.

All students competing must complete the entry form AND register to attend the conference by Saturday, January 25, 2023 at www.mnea.org/edrising. The conference registration fee is \$25. All students competing must complete the online entry form by **midnight, Jan. 25, 2023**. All entries that require advance submission of documents and links to videos must be emailed to Laurie.Bernskoetter@mnea.org by **Jan. 31, 2023**. All files should be labeled with the following format: LastName.FirstInitial.competition.material.2023. Example: Jarrett.A.ExplAdmin.Interview.2023.

Entrants grant Missouri National Education Association and the state coordinator of Educators Rising Missouri the right to post photos of students for promotional purposes on websites, social media, and printed materials. Entrants may not make any requests regarding their competition time. **Competitions will be held between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. March 15, 2023, in Fulton, MO, hosted by Westminster College.**

No substitutions on individual events after Mon., Feb. 6, 2023. For team events, one presenter substitution is allowed after Feb. 6 upon State Coordinator approval. To request approval, send an email with details to Laurie.Bernskoetter@mnea.org.
