


### Missouri Teacher of the Year Inspires



# Important Update COVID-19 Vaccinations: When will educators be eligible?

Missouri NEA believes the vaccination of public-school staff is an important step in getting all schools back to in-person learning. It is critical to ensure the health and safety of Missouri educators, so they can continue the important work of educating Missouri's youth.

This week, the State of Missouri announced new details about Missouri's COVID-19 vaccine distribution plan and availability. Missouri school districts are currently awaiting the delivery of vaccination supplies. School districts may enlist the help of MNEA local affiliates to devise vaccine implementation plans for their school district staff. School nurses vaccinated during Phase 1B-Tier 1 will assist with the vaccinations for school staff.

Phase 1B now includes the following priority tiers:

Priority	Included Population	Planned Activation Date
Tier 1	First responders and public health personnel (school nurses).	NOW ACTIVATED
Tier 2	Missourians who are at an increased risk for severe illness from COVID-19.	NOW ACTIVATED
Tier 3	Critical infrastructure workforce members, including teachers and school staff.	To be determined. Will begin upon the delivery of vaccine supplies.

## Vote for NEA R.A. State Delegate


Watch for email Feb. 1, 2021

# CMU Graduate Courses Earn up to nine credits per year for just \$225

For one low annual fee of \$225, Missouri NEA members may take one course each term (fall, spring and summer) to complete up to three graduate courses in 12 months. Or they may take two courses in the summer and skip either the fall or spring semester.

Each course is two or three graduate credit hours, so educators can earn from six to nine graduate credits. Choose from 17 self-paced, online courses for professional growth or salary advancement.

MNEA partners with Central Methodist University and Virtual Education Software to offer these courses. We recommend members check with their school districts to be sure these courses are accepted for salary schedule credit before signing up.

Free Micro-Credentials + Virtual Support = Professional Growth and Success

Missouri NEA and Kansas NEA Offer Joint Micro-Credential Professional Learning Opportunities!

A micro-credential is a short, competency-based recognition that allows an educator to demonstrate mastery in a particular area. NEA members are invited to participate in a virtual Professional Learning Community (PLC) to support your successful completion of an NEA Micro-credential. During this self-directed project-based professional development, you will collect evidence of proficiency in a specific area by working on a project designed to directly help you in your professional practice.

During this virtual PLC, a trained micro-credential facilitator will guide you and a group of fellow educators through the project by providing multiple opportunities for peer feedback during weekly support meetings via Zoom.
