Online Professional Development

LEGAL PERKS

\$4 Million Liability

Educators' employment liability coverage, automatic with membership, includes up to \$4 million in damages and legal fees for the defense of most job-related civil lawsuits and up to \$35,000 reimbursement for attorney fees in defending criminal charges arising out of job-related incidents in which the member is found innocent, or charges are dropped.

Free Job Protection

- Tenured members receive attorney review and/or representation if they face termination, suspension or demotion.
- Every member who is non-renewed or denied tenure has the option of receiving a legal consultation with an attorney to discuss the matter.
- Members who are subpoenaed to appear in court or administrative hearings related to what they might know or have seen in their jobs are entitled to consultation prior to testimony.

Free and Discounted Personal Legal Services

Members also get two free half-hour consultations with an attorney each year for personal matters, such as traffic violations, consumer protection, domestic relations, real estate issues and wills and estates. Additional time needed beyond your "free" time on these issues is billed to you at a 30 percent discount.

Missouri NEA supports the dignity and worth of our profession through the power of numbers, so that we each can focus on our individual tasks.

With the union's guidance, we have been able to gain more formal recognition from our administration and board, and we now have a legally binding contract. MNEA has been a catalyst in our political involvement, allowing us to educate voters so that they make informed choices on community college concerns. MNEA's support at meetings allows us a space for collegiality within our college and a broader grasp of our connections with educational issues across the state.

Free Insurance

Members receive, at no cost to them, insurance coverage of \$50,000 for job-related accidental death and dismemberment; up to \$1,000 in basic life insurance; and up to \$5,000 for accidental death and dismemberment that is not job related. New members also receive a \$15,000 life insurance policy their first year, which may be kept (or increased) and converted to an individual ongoing plan.

Free Magazines

NEA members get two free magazines each year. Order *Instructor*, filled with innovative and practical teaching ideas and a leading resource for K-8 teachers, or choose from a list of 40 popular magazines for your classroom, personal use or gift subscription.

Car Insurance

If you use MNEA's endorsed auto insurance, you pay zero deductible if your vehicle is vandalized or suffers collision damage while on or within 500 feet of school property, or while away from school on a school-authorized activity. This members-only benefit can save you \$250–\$500 per occurrence. MNEA members also get low group rates that are locked in for a year and can choose to pay over 10 or 12 months.

Renters/Homeowners Insurance

No matter where you choose to live, NEA covers you. Designed for educators, this policy offers coverage up to \$500 for lost or stolen fundraising cash or goods, \$3,000 for personal property used at school or at educational events away from home, and identity-theft protection at no cost.

Loans

Personal loans are available for \$5,000 to \$25,000 on your signature with affordable monthly payment terms up to 72 months and no application fees.
