LAST CHANCE WEBINAR The Public Service Loan Forgiveness Waiver is ending Oct. 31, 2022.

Attend the NEA Webinar Tues., Oct. 18 at 6 PM.

Since 2021, the Public Service Loan Forgiveness (PSLF) Waiver has provided \$10 billion in student loan forgiveness for over 175,000 educators and public service workers. After Oct. 31, the program will return to its regular program requirements. This means, if you had any past periods of ineligibility, those will no longer count for PSLF.






Missouri NEA Read-On Tour

After placing in the state Educators Rising competitions (sponsored by Missouri NEA) in March 2022, high-school students ventured to Washington, D.C. to compete nationally. Two Missouri students won scholarships, three earned high honors, ten placed in the top ten within their competition category, and 23 joined the ranks of the National Educators Rising Honor Society.
